#### Middle East

# 2 Cor Ch 12 Chapter 11 Key Points

Paul addressed w/ sarcasm and Holy Insights

- How to win the Spiritual War they (and we) face Daily (11:1-6)
  - Not w/ physical weapons but by Prayer, the Word of God, and the Holy Spirit
  - Perils of Deception and Seduction by False Teachers/Leaders
- True and False Christians, Pastors, and Teachers (11:7-15)
- Credentials of an Apostle (11:16-33)
- Today he continues the defense of his apostleship by talking about a vision

from the Lord and the Thorn in his side

#### 2 Cor Ch 12:1-4. Paul's Vision and His Thorn

- 12 I must go on boasting. Although there is nothing to be gained, I will go on to visions and revelations from the Lord.
- <sup>2</sup> I know a man in Christ who fourteen years ago was caught up to the third heaven. Whether it was in the body or out of the body I do not know—God knows.
- <sup>3</sup> And I know that this man—whether in the body or apart from the body I do not know, **but God knows**—
- <sup>4</sup> was caught up to **paradise** and heard <u>inexpressible things</u>, things that no one is permitted to tell

### People going to Heaven and Returning

- Lots of books, movies, and articles written today about this BUT
- When Jesus was talking with Nicodemus in John 13:13 No one has ever gone into heaven except the one who came from heaven—the Son of Man.
- What about Daniel and Ezekiel? Visions from the earth of Heaven
- Only 3 Jesus, Paul, and the Apostle John in Revelation
- Paul raptured to Heaven Paradise => Persian word that means the Garden of the Gods, or God's Garden.
- Third Heaven
  - Our atmosphere where birds fly is the 1<sup>st</sup> Heaven, (Deuteronomy 11:11; Psalm 104:12; Isaiah 55:10)
  - the area beyond the atmosphere where planets and Stars are is the **2**<sup>nd</sup> **Heaven**. (Psalm 8:3; Isaiah 13:10).
  - Beyond that the place where God dwells is the **3<sup>rd</sup> Heaven** (Psalm 33:13–14; Isaiah 66:1; Matthew 6:9; Hebrews 7:26; Revelation 11:19)
- Inexpressable things...No one permitted to tell

### 2 Cor Ch 12:5-7 A Thorn in his Flesh

- <sup>5</sup> I will boast about a man like that, **but I will not boast about myself, except about my weaknesses.**
- Fiven if I should choose to boast, I would not be a fool, because I would be speaking the truth. But I refrain, so by what I do or say, no one will think more of me than is warranted
- <sup>7</sup> or because of these surpassingly great revelations.

Therefore, in order to keep me from becoming conceited, I was given a **thorn in my flesh**, **a messenger of Satan, to torment me.** 

### 2 Cor Ch 12:8-10 Weakness and Strength

- <sup>8</sup> Three times I pleaded with the Lord to take it away from me.
- <sup>9</sup> But he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." Therefore, I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me.
- <sup>10</sup> That is why, for Christ's sake, I delight in weaknesses, in insults, in hardships, in persecutions, in difficulties. For when I am weak, then I am strong.

### 2 Cor Ch 12:11-13 Marks of an Apostle

- <sup>11</sup> I have made a fool of myself, but you drove me to it. I ought to have been commended by you, for <u>I am</u> not in the least inferior to the "super-apostles," even though I am nothing.
- <sup>12</sup> I persevered in demonstrating among you the marks of a true apostle, including signs, wonders, and miracles.
- <sup>13</sup> How were you inferior to the other churches, except that I was never a burden to you? Forgive me this wrong!

#### 2 Cor Ch 12:14-18

- <sup>14</sup> Now I am ready to visit you for the **third time**, and I will not be a burden to you, **because what I want is not your possessions but you**. After all, children should not have to save up for their parents, but parents for their children.
- <sup>15</sup> So | will very gladly spend for you everything I have and expend myself as well. If I love you more, will you love me less?
- <sup>16</sup> Be that as it may, I have not been a burden to you. Yet, crafty fellow that I am, I caught you by trickery!
- <sup>17</sup> Did I exploit you through any of the men I sent to you?
- <sup>18</sup> I urged Titus to go to you and I sent our brother with him. **Titus did not exploit you, did he? Did we not walk in the same footsteps by the same Spirit?**

# Unity of Action...

Paul uses humor to knock away the former criticism of him and his ministry. The <u>same footsteps</u> imply **a unity of action...** 

- Unity in the Spirit.
- Unity in the Love of each other.
- Unity in the commitment to Christ.
- Unity in the Lordship of Christ to us.

# 2 Cor Ch 12:19-20 Fear of What is to Come

- <sup>19</sup> Have you been thinking all along that we have been defending ourselves to you? We have been speaking in the sight of God as those in Christ; and everything we do, dear friends, is for your strengthening.
- <sup>20</sup> For I am afraid that when I come, I may not find you as I want you to be, and you may not find me as you want me to be.

I fear that there may be discord, jealousy, fits of rage, selfish ambition, slander, gossip, arrogance, and disorder.

### 2 Cor Ch 12:21 What Grieves Us?

<sup>21</sup> I am afraid that when I come again my God will humble me before you, and I will be grieved over many who have sinned earlier and have not repented of the impurity, sexual sin, and debauchery in which they have indulged.

Paul had a fear that they had not really repented and all of the bad fruit from that would appear before him, and he would be grieved the LACK OF REPENTANCE.
