1 Cor Ch 16:1-4. The Collection


16 Now about the collection for the Lord's people: **Do what**I told the Galatian churches to do.

² On the **first day of every week**, **each one of you should** set aside a sum of money *in keeping with your income*, saving it up, so that when I come no collections will have to be made.

³ Then, when I arrive, I will give letters of introduction to the men you approve and send them with your gift to Jerusalem.

⁴ If it seems advisable for me to go also, they will accompany me

1 Cor Ch 16:5-9 Personal Requests...

- ⁵ After I go through Macedonia, I will come to you—for I will be going through Macedonia.
- ⁶ Perhaps I will stay with you for a while, or even spend the winter, so that you can help me on my journey, wherever I go.
- ⁷ For I do not want to see you now and make only a passing visit; I hope to spend some time with you, if the Lord permits.
- ⁸ But I will stay on at Ephesus until Pentecost,
- ⁹ because **a great door for effective work has opened to me**, and there are many who oppose me.

1 Cor Ch 16:10-11 A beloved messenger...

¹⁰ When Timothy comes, see to it that he has nothing to fear while he is with you, for he is carrying on the work of the Lord, just as I am.

¹¹ No one, then, should treat him with contempt.

Send him on his way in peace so that he may return to me. I am expecting him along with the brothers.

1 Cor Ch 16:12-14

- ¹² Now about our brother Apollos: I strongly urged him to go to you with the brothers. He was quite unwilling to go now, but he will go when he has the opportunity.
- ¹³ Be on your guard; stand firm in the faith; be courageous; be strong.
- ¹⁴ Do everything in love.

1 Cor Ch 16:15-18 Ministers of the Lord

¹⁵ You know that the household of Stephanas were the first converts in Achaia, and they have devoted themselves to the service of the Lord's people.

I urge you, brothers and sisters,

¹⁶ to submit to such people and to everyone who joins in the work and labors at it.

¹⁷ I was glad when Stephanas, Fortunatus and Achaicus arrived, because they have supplied what was lacking from you.

¹⁸ For they refreshed my spirit and yours also.

Such men deserve recognition.

1 Cor Ch 16:19-24 Final Greetings...

- ¹⁹ The churches in the province of Asia send you greetings. Aquila and Priscilla greet you warmly in the Lord, and so does the church that meets at their house.
- ²⁰ All the brothers and sisters here send you greetings. *Greet one* another with a holy kiss.
- ²¹ I, Paul, write this greeting in my own hand.
- ²² If anyone does not love the Lord, let that person be cursed!
 - Come, Lord! (Marana tha)
- ²³ The grace of the Lord Jesus be with you.
- ²⁴ My love to all of you in Christ Jesus. *Amen.*

1 Corinthians... A quick summary

- Paul was in his 3rd missionary journey in Ephesus when he received a disturbing report on what was going on at Corinth.
- This letter addressed serious problems that were brought in from the Pagan roots of the believers
- Paul delivers a strong message of correction mixed with soaring chapters on Love, the Lords Supper, and the Resurrection.
- This letter was not well received and forced Paul to write 2nd Corinthians.
- We will study 2nd Corinthians after the HS Study
