

# Letter to the Galatians... How we got here



- First Missionary Journey with Barnabus
- Galatia close to Tarsus, Paul's hometown
- Towns of Derbe, Lystra, Iconium, and Antioch in Pisidea
- Where a disagreement between Paul and Barnabus split the team.
- Paul visited the Galatian churches in each of his 3 missionary journies.

#### Who were the Galatians?



- Gaul's were a Celtic clan from France
- Warlike but other positive attributes.
- Moved to the province to be later named Galatia by the king of Byzantium to help him in a civil war.
- They stayed there and the province was named Gaul-atia
- Under Roman rule they became Galatia

# Galatians Ch 1:1-5 Opening and benediction

1 Paul, an apostle—sent not from men nor by a man, but by Jesus Christ and God the Father, who raised him from the dead—

<sup>2</sup> and all the brothers and sisters with me,

#### To the churches in Galatia:

<sup>3</sup> Grace and peace to you from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ,

<sup>4</sup> who gave himself for our sins to rescue us from the present evil age, according to the will of our God and Father,

<sup>5</sup> to whom be **glory for ever and ever.** 

Amen.

# Galatians Ch 1:6-9. No Other Gospel

- <sup>6</sup> I am astonished that you are so quickly deserting the one who called you to live in the grace of Christ and are turning to a different gospel—
- <sup>7</sup> which is really no gospel at all. Evidently some people are throwing you into confusion and are trying to pervert the gospel of Christ.
- <sup>8</sup> But even if we or an angel from heaven should preach a gospel other than the one we preached to you, let them be under God's curse!
- <sup>9</sup> As we have already said, **so now I say again**: If **anybody** is preaching to you a gospel other than what you accepted, let them be under God's curse!

# Galatians Ch 1:10-12 Paul Called by God

- <sup>10</sup> Am I now trying to win the approval of human beings, or of God? Or am I trying to please people? If I were still trying to please people, I would not be a servant of Christ.
- <sup>11</sup> I want you to know, brothers and sisters, that the gospel I preached is **not of human origin.**
- <sup>12</sup> I did not receive it from any man, nor was I taught it; rather, I received it by revelation from Jesus Christ.

## Galatians Ch 1:13-20 Paul's statement

- <sup>13</sup> For you have heard of **my previous way of life in Judaism**, how intensely I persecuted the church of God and tried to destroy it.
- <sup>14</sup> I was advancing in Judaism beyond many of my own age among my people and was extremely zealous for the traditions of my fathers.
- <sup>15</sup> But when God, who set me apart from my mother's womb and called me by his grace, was pleased
- <sup>16</sup> to reveal his Son in me so that I might preach him among the Gentiles, my immediate **response was not to consult any human being.**
- <sup>17</sup> I did not go up to Jerusalem to see those who were apostles before I was, but I went into Arabia. Later I returned to Damascus.
- <sup>18</sup> Then after three years, I went up to Jerusalem to get acquainted with Cephas and stayed with him fifteen days.
- <sup>19</sup> I saw none of the other apostles—only James, the Lord's brother.
- <sup>20</sup> I assure you before God that what I am writing you is no lie.

## Galatians Ch 1:21-24

- <sup>21</sup> Then I went to Syria and Cilicia.
- <sup>22</sup> I was personally unknown to the churches of Judea that are in Christ.
- <sup>23</sup> They only heard the report: "The man who formerly persecuted us is now preaching the faith he once tried to destroy."
- <sup>24</sup> And they praised God because of me.
