US/World


- Massive Early Voting turnout. Still appears to be very close

- We will take our time to go through this study. It is Important!



Our Journey into the beginnings...of everything

- Many of us have commentaries on the Old Testament that deal with Genesis in the same way that they deal with other books of the Bible. Still, before we get to an individual book/chapter study, we must step back and take a wider look at this book... Step back to the beginning.
- I connect with this commentary because Dr. Morris was an Engineer, a Scientist, and a Strong believer in the authority and accuracy of the Bible. Plus, he was an organized and gifted teacher and writer. This book takes a scientific approach to Genesis and Creation. For many of us, this gives us some scientific understanding and mental comprehension of creation.

Although there are more than 20 commentaries on Genesis currently in print, there is a unique need for this one. So far as we know, this is the only commentary on the complete Book of Genesis written by a Creation Scientist."

Why is this important?

- If we believe that the Bible is the true and accurate Word of the Lord to us, then the stories in Genesis are not merely entertaining but contain the actual truth of creation.
- Many Churches and Scholars do not teach the words and precepts as truth but rather as Allegories mixed with vague truths. The notion of Evolution so prevalent in education today has weakened the teaching of this great book.
- Our understanding is critical to a Biblical Foundation for the rest of the Bible to be seen as Truth. From a scientific explanation, the more archeology and history we uncover, the more the Bible shows itself to be a reliable and truthful account.
- While Genesis is an important study for the complete book, I will focus on the first 12 chapters that take us from Creation to the Calling of Abraham

Beginnings and Foundations...

- One could argue that the Book of Genesis is the most important book ever written, and even critics would agree it has had profound persuasion on the ideas that have shaped modern society.
- Without the foundational quality of this book, it would be like a building with no foundation trying to stay upright in the chaos of life's storms and floods.
- Many people, including many Christians, would like to remove Genesis from the Bible altogether because it presents a set of problems that require honest belief and acceptance.
- While creation history tries to explain the natural events that brought the world we know into existence, the Book of Genesis takes a different approach and explains what happened and why ...from God's point of view.
- His point of view and the reasons behind the creation cannot be overstated as we try and explain God's actions with His People, and mankind in general in the balance of the OT and NT. Without this understanding, the Bible and its redemptive purposes are not clearly seen.
- While secular History provides an animalistic, naturalistic narrative of the world, the Book of Origins provides a true and reliable account of the origins of **all entities** of the universe **and of life itself.**

Before Creation...What we need to understand

- Genesis sets this all up with the **Origin of Matter** itself. Without Matter, nothing could be **created** or **procreated**.
- God also created what we call "time." According to the Bible, there was a time when Time did not exist, and there will be a time when Time goes away.
- Even harder to think about is that **God created the idea of Space**—not Outer Space, but the 3-dimensional place where all things are stored.

Time, Matter, and Space are the building blocks of Creation.

One of the larger Q's we need to deal with is about God Himself...

Where did God come from? An interesting Q for sure, but it points out our own limitations when it comes to comprehending God

God is Self-Existent

God existed Before Time, Before Matter, and Before Space. When we ask Q's like where did God come from? We are placing Him in a restriction of either time, space, or matter. He is not restricted by any of these and is outside of all of them. I know this is a mind-blowing thought, but God is self-existent...He has always been...

Definition : self-existent -self-ex·is·tent

<u>Adjective</u>

<u>existing</u> of or by oneself or itself <u>independently of any other being or cause</u>: not caused to exist by someone or something else

This whole concept of God and Creation is hard for people to get their minds around. It seems fanciful and incomprehensible...yet here we are, and we must accept these things as a matter of faith.

Is Genesis Truth or Myth?

• Most criticisms of the Book of Genesis are confined to Chapters 1-11, where God is supernaturally active, and some believe this is a myth. Our study will encompass these Chapters and then the calling of Abram.

Is Genesis truth or myth?

- I guess it is in the eye of the beholder, but did you know that Genesis is the most referenced book in the OT and NT?
- Referenced by events, people, and prophets in 15 places in the OT and 11 in the NT.
- One hundred sixty-five passages in Genesis are either directly quoted or referred to in the NT (TGR).
- Also, each of the 11 chapters most rejected is mentioned in the NT many more than 1 time.
- Jesus Christ Himself quoted from or referenced these people, or events, from the first 7 chapters.

So, what does this all mean?

• It means that they implicitly accepted these narratives as the Word of God and therefore true without question.

There is no evidence of any waffling on this truth in the NT at all.

- It also means that one cannot reject the historicity and divine authority of Genesis without undermining the authority of the entire Bible.
- The alternative of believing the rest of the Bible and not Genesis is a nod to our own lack of understanding of the true nature and presence of an Almighty and Ever-Present God
- If Jesus and the Apostles accepted the author and people of the book of Genesis and the narrative it provides...Who am I to disagree?

OK, Who wrote the Book of Genesis?

As I mentioned when we Studied **God's Appointed Times**, the Jews believe it was written by Moses and given to them at Mount Sinai along with the tablets of stone. Many believe Moses received inspiration from God at Sinai and the understanding to write the first 5 books of the OT, called the **Torah**.

- This is the common understanding of most Christians and Jews, but others believe Genesis was written by many people later in time. This is because they doubt the existence of monotheism and culture to write such a book in the time of Moses.
- These critical theories have largely disappeared as geologists have uncovered many artifacts that confirm both the existence of Monotheism and advanced culture in Moses himself and the culture in general.

If we can agree that Moses wrote the Book of Genesis, how did it come to him? Generally, two theories might apply.

- 1. It was dictated to him by the Holy Spirit, and Moses simply wrote it down.
- 2. The Holy Spirit passed it to him as Oral History, and Moses wrote and compiled it into the finished work we have now, the Book of Genesis.

Genesis can be divided into 9 main groupings:

- 1. The Generations of the Heavens and the Earth (Gen 1.1-2.4a)
- 2. The Book of the Generations of Adam (Gen 2:4b-5:1a)
- 3. The Generations of Noah (Gen 5:1b-6:9a)
- 4. The Generations of the Sons of Noah (Gen 6:9b-10:1a)
- 5. The Generations of Shem (Gen 10:1b- 11:10a)
- 6. The Generations of Terah (Gen 11:10b- 11:27)
- 7. The Generations of Isaac (Gen11:27b- 25:19)
- 8. The Generations of Jacob (Gen 25:19b-37:2)
- 9. The Generations of the Sons of Jacob (Gen 37:2b- Exodus 1:1)

Principles of Interpretation

- I will follow the principle that unless the Bible says it is an allegory, I will treat is a literal truth. Others use the Allegory Method of interpretation that assumes most of the first 11 chapters are not literal. For example, that Adam or Eve were not real people, the Garden of Eden is not a real place, and the discussions and genealogies are not real but metaphorical. I cannot do this way of thinking so I will not.
- Finally, others see Genesis as a "Type" and the references in it are just images of things to come in the NT or life of Christ. While there are many examples of ties between Genesis and the NT stories and life of Christ, they are regarded as pre-conditioning believers for what is to come. For example, the First Adam and the Second Adam in Romans. Eve as a type of the Church in Ephesians 5, and Abraham and Isaac as a prototype of The Father and Son being sacrificed for all.
- TYPES are really illustrations for us to deepen our understanding of the scripture, and not to be taken allegory. These were real and treated that way in the Bible...in both Testaments.

Finally – Genesis is Anticipation for Eternity
