# Happy Mother's Day

Gen 1:26

<sup>26</sup> Then God said, "Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; and let **them** rule over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the sky and over the cattle and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth." <sup>27</sup> God created man in His own image, in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them. <sup>28</sup> God blessed them; and God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the earth, and subdue it;

#### What did we learn in Habakkuk Ch 2?

- Habakkuk is waiting and watching for God to answer his Q's
- God answers and gives him a message to write down on tablets and herald in the land of Judah (and to us)
- God uses people who are not pure to exact judgment on those who trust in themselves, and not God's word
- The Just shall live by faith
- Selfish Ambition, Covetousness, exploitation of people, drunkenness and violence, and idolatry will be punished in Gods timing and His way.

3 A prayer of Habakkuk the prophet, according to **Shigionoth**.

<sup>2</sup> LORD, I have heard the report about You, and I fear. O LORD, revive Your work in the midst of the years, In the midst of the years make it known; In wrath remember mercy.

#### Habakkuk Ch 3:3-7 The Greatness of God

- <sup>3</sup> God comes from **Teman**, And **the Holy One** from Mount Paran. Selah. His splendor covers the heavens, And the earth is full of His praise.

  <sup>4</sup> His radiance is like the sunlight; He has rays flashing from His hand, And there is the hiding of His power.
- <sup>5</sup> Before Him goes pestilence, And plague comes after Him.
- <sup>6</sup> He stood and surveyed the earth; He looked and startled the nations. Yes, the perpetual mountains were shattered, The ancient hills collapsed. **His ways are everlasting.**
- <sup>7</sup> I saw the tents of **Cushan** under distress, The tent curtains of the **land of Midian were trembling**.

# Habakkuk Ch 3:8-11 God Marching to Victory

<sup>8</sup> Did the LORD rage against the rivers, Or was Your anger against the rivers,

Or was Your wrath against the sea, That You rode on Your horses, On Your chariots of salvation?

<sup>9</sup> Your bow was made bare; The rods of chastisement were sworn. **Selah.** 

You cleaved the earth with rivers.

<sup>10</sup> The mountains saw You and quaked; The downpour of waters swept by.

The deep uttered forth its voice, It lifted high its hands.

<sup>11</sup> Sun and moon stood in their places; They went away at the light of Your arrows, At the radiance of Your gleaming spear.

#### Habakkuk Ch 3:12-15

- <sup>12</sup> In indignation You marched through the earth; In anger You trampled the nations.
- <sup>13</sup> You went forth for the salvation of Your people, For the salvation of Your anointed. **You struck the head of the house of the evil**

To lay him open from thigh to neck. Selah.

- <sup>14</sup> You pierced with his own spears the head of his throngs. They stormed in to scatter us; Their exultation was like those Who devour the oppressed in secret.
- <sup>15</sup> You trampled on the sea with Your horses, On the surge of many waters.

# Habakkuk Ch 3:16-18 Faith Emerges

<sup>16</sup> I heard and my inward parts trembled, at the sound my lips quivered.

Decay enters my bones, and in my place I tremble.

Because I must wait quietly for the day of distress, for the people to arise who will invade us.

<sup>17</sup> Though the fig tree should not blossom and there be no fruit on the vines, though the yield of the olive should fail, and the fields produce no food,

Though the flock should be cut off from the fold And there be no cattle in the stalls,

<sup>18</sup> Yet I will exult in the LORD, I will rejoice in the God of my salvation
