



Matt Ch 26:17-21 The Last Supper


- ¹⁷ On the first day of the Festival of Unleavened Bread, the disciples came to Jesus and asked, "Where do you want us to make preparations for you to eat the Passover?"
- ¹⁸ He replied, "Go into the city to a certain man and tell him, 'The Teacher says: My appointed time is near. I am going to celebrate the Passover with my disciples at your house.'"
- ¹⁹ So the disciples did as Jesus had directed them and prepared the Passover.
- ²⁰ When evening came, Jesus was **reclining at the table with the Twelve.**
- ²¹ And **while they were eating**, he said, "Truly I tell you, one of you will betray me."

Matt Ch 26:22-30 The Passover Celebration Meal

- ²² They were very sad and began to say to him one after the other, "Surely you don't mean me, Lord?"
- ²³ Jesus replied, "The one who has dipped his hand into the bowl with me will betray me. ²⁴ The Son of Man will **go just as it is** written about him. But woe to that man who betrays the Son of Man! It would be better for him if he had not been born."
- ²⁵ Then Judas, the one who would betray him, said, <u>"Surely you</u> don't mean me, Rabbi?"

Jesus answered, "You have said so."

Probable Seating at the Meal



- Jesus was the HOST
- To His Right was John
- To His Left the <u>Seat of Honor</u> was Judas
- Peter sat next to John in the least position
- Others we don't know where they sat
- The shape of the table is unknown –
 U shaped, or oblong, as pictured

Not like DaVinci's famous Painting

Exodus 6:6-7 Four Cup Promises of the Passover

- ⁶ "Therefore, say to the Israelites: 'I am the Lord, and I will bring you out from under the yoke of the Egyptians. I will free you from being slaves to them, and I will redeem you with an outstretched arm and with mighty acts of judgment.
- ⁷ I will take you as my own people, and I will be your God. Then you will know that I am the Lord your God, who brought you out from under the yoke of the Egyptians.
- ⁸ And I will bring you to **the land** I swore with uplifted hand to give to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob. I will give it to you as a possession. I am the Lord."
- 1. I will bring you out Cup 1
- 2. I will free you from slavery Cup 2
- 3. I will redeem you Cup 3
- 4. I will take you as my people, and I will be your God Cup 4

The final Land Promise is the unconditional and eternal gift of the Land

Matt Ch 26:26-30 What about the 4th Cup?

- ²⁶ While they were eating, Jesus took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it and gave it to his disciples, saying, "Take and eat; this is my body."
- ²⁷ Then he took a cup, and when he had given thanks, he gave it to them, saying, "Drink from it, **all** of you.
- ²⁸ This is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins.
- ²⁹ I tell you, I will not drink from this fruit of the vine from now on until that day when I drink it new with you in my Father's kingdom."
- ³⁰ When they had **sung a hymn**, they went out to the Mount of Olives

Matt Ch 26:30-35 Peters Denial Front and Center

- ³¹ Then Jesus told them, "This very night you will **all** fall away on account of me, for it is written:
- "'I will strike the shepherd, and the sheep of the flock will be scattered.' (Zech 13:7)
- 32 But after I have risen, I will go ahead of you into Galilee."
- ³³ Peter replied, "Even if all fall away on account of you, I never will."
- 34 "Truly I tell you," Jesus answered, "this very night, before the rooster crows, you will disown me three times."
- ³⁵ But Peter declared, "Even if I have to die with you, I will never disown you." And all the other disciples said the same.

Matthew 26:36-45 Gethsemane

- ³⁶ Then Jesus went with his disciples to a place called **Gethsemane**, and he said to them, "Sit here while I go over there and pray."
- ³⁷ He took **Peter and the two sons of Zebedee** along with him, **and he began to be sorrowful and troubled.**
- ³⁸ Then he said to them, "My soul is overwhelmed with sorrow to the point of death. Stay here and keep watch with me."
- ³⁹ Going a little farther, he fell with his face to the ground and prayed, "My Father, if it is possible, may this cup be taken from me. <u>Yet not as I will, but as you will."</u>
- ⁴⁰ Then he returned to his disciples and found them sleeping. "Couldn't you men keep watch with me for one hour?" he asked Peter.

Matthew 26:41-45 Keeping watch...eyes closed

- ⁴¹ "Watch and pray so that you will not fall <u>into temptation</u>. The spirit is willing, but the flesh is weak."
- ⁴² He went away a second time and prayed, "My Father, if it is not possible for this cup to be taken away unless I drink it, may your will be done."
- ⁴³ When he came back, he **again found them sleeping because their eyes** were heavy.
- ⁴⁴ So he left them (asleep) and went away once more and prayed the **third time, saying the same thing.**
- ⁴⁵ Then he returned to the disciples and said to them, "Are you still sleeping and resting? Look, the hour has come, and the Son of Man is delivered into the hands of sinners.
- 46 Rise! Let us go! Here comes my betrayer!"

Matt 26:47-51 Jesus arrested

- While he was still speaking, Judas, one of the Twelve, arrived. With him was a large crowd armed with swords and clubs, sent from the chief priests and the elders of the people.
- ⁴⁸ Now the betrayer had arranged a signal with them: "The one I kiss is the man; arrest him."
- ⁴⁹ Going at once to Jesus, Judas said, "Greetings, Rabbi!" and kissed him.
- ⁵⁰ Jesus replied, "Do what you came for, friend."
- Then the men stepped forward, seized Jesus and arrested him.
- ⁵¹ With that, one of Jesus' companions reached for his sword, drew it out and struck the servant of the high priest, cutting off his ear.

Matt 26:52-56 Jesus speaks to the crowd

- ⁵² "Put your sword back in its place," Jesus said to him, "for all who draw the sword will die by the sword.
- ⁵³ Do you think I cannot call on my Father, and he will at once put at my disposal more than twelve legions of angels?
- ⁵⁴ But how then would the Scriptures be fulfilled that say it must happen in this way?"
- ⁵⁵ In that hour Jesus said to the crowd, "Am I leading a rebellion, that you have come out with swords and clubs to capture me? Every day I sat in the temple courts teaching, and you did not arrest me.
- ⁵⁶ But this has all taken place that the writings of the prophets might be fulfilled." Then all the disciples deserted him and fled.

Matt 26:57-63 Jesus at the Sanhedrin

- ⁵⁷ Those who had arrested Jesus took him to Caiaphas the high priest, where the teachers of the law and the elders had assembled.
- ⁵⁸ **But Peter followed him at a distance**, right up to the courtyard of the high priest. He entered and sat down with the guards to see the outcome.
- ⁵⁹ The chief priests and the whole Sanhedrin were **looking for false evidence against Jesus so that they could put him to death.**
- ⁶⁰ But they did not find any, though many false witnesses came forward.
- Finally, two came forward
- ⁶¹ and declared, "This fellow said, 'I am able to destroy the temple of God and rebuild it in three days."
- ⁶² Then the high priest stood up and said to Jesus, "Are you not going to answer? What is this testimony that these men are bringing against you?"
- ⁶³ But Jesus remained silent.

The high priest said to him, "I charge you under oath by the living God: Tell us if you are the Messiah, the Son of God.

Matt 26:64-68 Jesus inflames the Jews

64 "You have said so," Jesus replied. "But I say to all of you: From now on you will see the Son of Man sitting at the right hand of the Mighty One and coming on the clouds of heaven."

⁶⁵ Then the high priest <u>tore his clothes</u> and said, "He has spoken blasphemy! Why do we need any more witnesses? Look, now you have heard the blasphemy.

66 What do you think?"

"He is worthy of death," they answered.

⁶⁷ Then they **spit in his face** and **struck him with their fists**. **Others slapped him**

68 and said, "Prophesy to us, Messiah. Who hit you?"

Ps 110:1 and Daniel 7:13-14

Ps 110:1
The Lord says to my lord:
"Sit at my right hand
until I make your enemies
a footstool for your feet."

Daniel 7:13-14

13 "In my vision at night I looked, and there before me was one like a son of man, coming with the clouds of heaven. He approached the Ancient of Days and was led into his presence. 14 He was given authority, glory and sovereign power; all nations and peoples of every language worshiped him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion that will not pass away, and his kingdom is one that will never be destroyed

Matt Ch 26:69-74 Peter disowns Jesus

- ⁶⁹ Now Peter was **sitting out in the courtyard**, and a servant girl came to him. **"You also were with Jesus of Galilee,"** she said.
- ⁷⁰ But he denied it before them all. "I don't know what you're talking about," he said.
- ⁷¹ Then <u>he went out to the gateway</u>, where another servant girl saw him and said to the people there, "This fellow was with Jesus of Nazareth."
- 72 He denied it again, with an oath: "I don't know the man!"
- ⁷³ After a little while, those standing there went up to Peter and said, "Surely you are one of them; your accent gives you away."
- ⁷⁴ Then he began to call down curses, and he swore to them, "I don't know the man!"

Immediately a rooster crowed.

⁷⁵ Then Peter remembered the word Jesus had spoken: "Before the rooster crows, you will disown me three times." And he went outside and wept bitterly.
