ICYMI Update

Middle East

- It appears like the US is strongly pressuring Israel to stop its incursion into Rafah where the 100+ hostages and remaining Hamas Terrorists are hiding.
- Israel is moving ahead to finish the job in Gaza
- Renewed efforts by Qatar and others for a cease-fire. Some movement this week
- Egypt tunnels, walls, and troops
- Iran keeps it up Hezbollah, Houthis, and Proxy militias in Iraq
- Israel getting support from many including Azerbaijan

US Border

- Foreign Nationals coming across border... China, Iran, Middle East
- Election processes underway ...many points of disagreement incl. Abortion, Second Amendment, Border and Terror challenges, Israel support and antisemitism in colleges, government, and activists. Chaos coming and Pandemic

Micah

- Last week we discussed the setting of the book, its author and timing, and the contemporaries of Micah.
- We looked at the 3 oracles of God that are laid out in this prophecy:
 - 1. A Warning that Judgment is Coming (1:1-2:13)
 - 2. A Promise that a Deliverer/Ruler is Coming (3:1-5:15)
 - 3. A Challenge to Trust the Lord (6:1-7:20)

Today we pick up at Micah Ch 2 and finish the warning about a Judgment to come

Questions we need to think about first...

Many Christians and Jews alike today have the thought that God would never permit this kind of judgment and suffering for his people... Either his Covenant people (Jews) or his Delivered people (the church).

Amos 3:2 Speaks to the Jews

² "You only have I chosen of all the families of the earth; therefore, I will **punish you** for all your sins."

Gal 6:7 to believers

Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a person sows, this he will also reap

What do we make of this?

- God disciplines HIS children to get them to follow Him and Obey His Word.
- Privilege leads to Responsibility which leads to Accountability
- This is a recurrent theme throughout the OT of the Jews FAITHLESSNESS to the Lord

In Micah 2:1-11 the prophet accuses them of 2 particular sins:

- Covetousness vv1-5
- Listening to False Prophets vv6-11

Sins as old as those of Adam and Eve

Micah Ch 2:1-2 Human plans & God's Plans

2:1 Woe to those who plan iniquity, to those who plot evil on their beds! At morning's light, they carry it out because it is in their power to do it. ² They covet fields and seize them, and houses, and take them. They defraud people of their homes, they rob them of their inheritance.

Micah Ch 2:3-5 God's Discipline

³ Therefore, the Lord says:

"I am planning disaster against this people, from which you cannot save yourselves. You will no longer walk proudly, for it will be a time of calamity. ⁴ In that day **people will ridicule you**; they will taunt you with this mournful song: 'We are utterly ruined; my people's possession is divided up. He takes it from me! He assigns our fields to traitors."

⁵ Therefore you will have no one in the assembly of the Lord to divide the land by lot.

Micah Ch 2:6-7A. Their Prophets speak to Micah

"Do not prophesy," their prophets say.
"Do not prophesy about these things; disgrace will not overtake us."
You descendants of Jacob, should it be said, "Does the Lord (or Lord's Spirit) become impatient?

Does he do such things?"

Micah Ch 2:7B-9 The Lord replies to the false prophets

- "Do not my words do good to the one whose ways are upright?
- ⁸ Lately **my people** have risen up like an enemy.
- You strip off the rich robe from those who pass by without a care, like men returning from battle.
- You drive the women of my people from their pleasant homes.
 You take away my blessing from their children forever.

Micah Ch 2:10-11 Judgment rendered

For this is not your resting place,
because it is defiled,
it is ruined, beyond all remedy.

11 If a liar and deceiver comes and says,
'I will prophesy for you plenty of wine and beer,'
that would be just the prophet for this people!

Micah Ch 2: 12-14 Deliverance and Hope

the Lord at their head."

12 "I will surely gather all of you, Jacob; I will surely bring together the remnant of Israel. I will bring them together like sheep in a pen, like a flock in its pasture; the place will throng with people. 13 The One who breaks open the way will go up before them; they will break through the gate and go out. Their King will pass through before them,

The Glorious Promise for the Future

God will punish, but He will also provide a Deliverer / Redeemer

God will regather the remnant in the Land

He will protect and feed them in their pastures restoring the desolate

There will be many of them, and they will be led by the Lord.

The Lord will open the gates that restrict them and open them up to following Him wherever He leads them

Status today in 2024

Do these promises apply to us?

- Yes, while Israel is back in the land, and the promises to them are coming true before our eyes every day in the news
- We are the Bride of Christ (Redeemed Church) and according to Prophecy:
- > We will be removed before the time of Jacobs Trouble
- Taken to be with the Lord in the Rapture of the Church
- Live forever with Jesus in both the New Earth and New Heaven
