Micah Recap

- In week 1 (ch 1), we discussed the setting of the book, its author and timing, and the contemporaries of Micah.
- We looked at the 3 oracles of God that are laid out in this prophecy:
 - 1. A Warning that Judgment is Coming (1:1-2:13)
 - 2. A Promise that a Deliverer/Ruler is Coming (3:1-5:15)
 - 3. A Challenge to Trust the Lord (6:1-7:20)
- In week 2 (Ch 2) we finished the first Oracle of Judgment with an accusation of Sin, a warning of impending judgment, and the promise of a deliverer
- **Today in week 3** (ch 3) we will take a closer look at judgments coming and the promise of a deliverer and new Ruler.

Micah 3:1-3 A Rebuke of the Prophets and Rulers

3 Then I said, "Listen, you leaders of Jacob, you rulers of Israel. Should you not embrace justice, you who hate good and love evil; who tear the skin from my people and the flesh from their bones; ³ who eat my people's flesh, strip off their skin and break their bones in pieces; who chop them up like meat for the pan, like flesh for the pot?"

⁴ Then they will cry out to the Lord, but he will not answer them. At that time, he will hide his face from them because of the evil they have done.

Isaiah and Micah

- Contemporaries with a similar message to the House of Jacob
- Judgment coming, but Hope and Redemption coming as well
- **Note:** If a prophecy is from God, one would expect the views to be the same across prophets with slight differences in wording, as it is here.
- Isaiah was born before Micah and lived longer than Micah and his book encompasses more history, but Micah most likely wrote first and Isaiah later...but not clear since they write about the same subject.
- Micah is shorter and was written completely much earlier. Isaiah was written over many years and covers events before and after the taking of Israel by the Assyrians.
