# Philippians 3:1-3

**3 Further, my brothers and sisters, rejoice in the Lord! It is no trouble for me to write the same things to you again, and it is a safeguard for you.**

**2 Watch out for those dogs, those evildoers, those mutilators of the flesh.**

**3 For it is we who are the circumcision, we who serve God by his Spirit, who boast in Christ Jesus, and who put no confidence in the flesh—**

# Philippians 3: 4-6 *Paul has every reason...*

*<sup>4</sup> though I myself have reasons for such confidence.*

*If someone else thinks they have reasons to put confidence in the flesh, I have more:*

*<sup>5</sup> circumcised on the eighth day, of the people of Israel (**Jacob**), of the tribe of Benjamin, a Hebrew of Hebrews; in regard to the law, a Pharisee;*

*<sup>6</sup> as for zeal, persecuting the church; as for righteousness based on the law, faultless.*

# Philippians Ch 3:7-9

***<sup>7</sup> But whatever were gains to me I now consider loss for the sake of Christ.***

***<sup>8</sup> What is more, I consider everything a loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord, for whose sake I have lost all things. I consider them garbage, that I may gain Christ***

***<sup>9</sup> and be found in him, not having a righteousness of my own that comes from the law, but that which is through faith in Christ—the righteousness that comes from God on the basis of faith***

# Philippians 3:10-12

<sup>10</sup> *I want to **know** Christ—yes, to **know** the power of his resurrection and participation in his sufferings, becoming like him in his death,*

<sup>11</sup> *and so, somehow, attaining to the resurrection from the dead.*

<sup>12</sup> *Not that I have already obtained all this, or have already arrived at my goal, **but I press on to take hold of that for which Christ Jesus took hold of me***

# Philippians Ch 3:13-14

*<sup>13</sup> Brothers and sisters, I do not consider myself yet to have taken hold of it. But one thing I do (know): **Forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead,***

*<sup>14</sup> **I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus.***



# Philippians Ch 3:15-18

***<sup>15</sup> All of us, then, who are mature should take such a view of things. And if on some point you think differently, that too God will make clear to you.***

***<sup>16</sup> Only let us live up to what we have already attained.***

***<sup>17</sup> Join together in following my example, brothers and sisters, and just as you have us as a model, keep your eyes on those who live as we do.***

***<sup>18</sup> For, as I have often told you before and now tell you again even with tears, **many live as enemies of the cross of Christ.*****



# Philippians Ch 3:19-21 *Our Glorious Hope*

<sup>19</sup> Their *destiny is destruction, their god is their stomach (earthly desires), and their glory is in their shame. Their mind is set on earthly things.*

<sup>20</sup> *But our citizenship is in heaven. And we eagerly await a Savior from there, the Lord Jesus Christ,*

<sup>21</sup> *who, by the power that enables him to bring everything under his control, will transform our lowly bodies so that they will be like his glorious body*
