Philippians Ch 4:1-3. Closing appeal

4 Therefore, my brothers and sisters, you whom I love and long for, **my joy** and **crown**, **stand firm in the Lord** in this way, dear friends!

2 I **plead** with **Euodia** and I **plead with Syntyche** to be of the same mind in the Lord.

3 Yes, and I ask you, my true companion, **help these women** since they have contended at my side in the cause of the gospel, along with Clement and the rest of my co-workers, whose names are in the book of life.

Philippians Ch 4:4-7

⁴ Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again:
Rejoice!

⁵ Let your **gentleness be evident** to all. **The Lord is near.**

⁶ Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God.

⁷ And **the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.**

Philippians Ch 4:8-9

⁸ Finally, brothers and sisters, **whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things.**

⁹ **Whatever you have learned or received or heard from me or seen in me—*put it into practice.* And the God of peace will be with you.**

Philippians Ch 4:10-13 Thank you for the Gifts

¹⁰ I rejoiced greatly in the Lord that at last you renewed your concern for me. Indeed, you were (always) concerned, but you had no opportunity to show it.

¹¹ I am not saying this because I am in need, for **I have learned to be content whatever the circumstances.**

¹² I know what it is to be in need, and I know what it is to have plenty. **I have learned the secret of being content in any and every situation, whether well fed or hungry, whether living in plenty or in want.**

¹³ *I can do all this through him who gives me strength.*

Philippians Ch 4:14-20

¹⁴ Yet it was good of you to share in my troubles.

¹⁵ Moreover, as you Philippians know, in the early days of your acquaintance with the gospel, when I set out from Macedonia, **not one church shared with me in the matter of giving and receiving, except you only;**

¹⁶ for even when I was in Thessalonica, you sent me aid more than once when I was in need.

¹⁷ Not that I desire your gifts; **what I desire is that more be credited to your account.**

¹⁸ I have received **full payment** and have more than enough. I am amply supplied, now that I have received from Epaphroditus the gifts you sent. **They are a fragrant offering, an acceptable sacrifice, pleasing to God.**

¹⁹ **And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus.**

²⁰ To our God and Father be glory for ever and ever. Amen.

Philippians Ch 4:21-23 *Final Greetings*

²¹ Greet **all God's people** *in Christ Jesus*. The brothers and sisters who are with me send greetings.

²² All God's people here send you greetings, **especially those who belong to Caesar's household.**

²³ The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ be with *your spirit*.
