Philippians 1: 3-6 Thanksgiving and Prayer

³ I thank **my God** every time I remember you.

⁴ In **all my prayers** for **all of you**, I always pray with joy

⁵ because of your **partnership in the gospel** from the **first day until now**,

⁶ being confident of this, **that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus**.

Philippians 1:7-8

⁷ ***It is right for me to feel this way*** about all of you, since ***I have you in my heart*** and, **whether I am in chains or defending and confirming the gospel, all of you share in God's grace with me.**

⁸ **God can testify how I long for all of you with the affection of Christ Jesus.**

Philippians 1:9-11

⁹ And this is my prayer: that your love may abound more and more in knowledge and depth of insight,

¹⁰ so that you may be able to discern what is best and may be pure and blameless for the day of Christ,

¹¹ filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ—to the glory and praise of God.

Philippians Ch 1:12 Paul's view from in chains

- The Philippians had expressed concern both about Paul's well being but also, they worried about his ability to fulfill his role as Apostle to the Gentiles.
- He had been under house arrest for 2 years

Paul tries to allay their fears

¹² Now I want you to know, brothers and sisters, that what has happened to me has actually served to advance the gospel.
