Philippians Ch 1: 1-2

1 Paul and Timothy, servants of Christ Jesus,
To all God's holy people in Christ Jesus at
Philippi, together with the overseers and deacons:

² Grace and peace to you from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

Philippians 1: 3-6 Thanksgiving and Prayer

- ³ I thank **my God** every time I remember you.
- ⁴ In all my prayers for all of you, I always pray with joy
- ⁵ because of your partnership in the gospel from the first day until now,
- being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus.

Philippians 1:7-8

⁷ It is right for me to feel this way about all of you, since I have you in my heart and, whether I am in chains or defending and confirming the gospel, all of you share in God's grace with me.

⁸ God can testify how I long for all of you with the affection of Christ Jesus.

Philippians 1:9-11

⁹ And this is my prayer: that your love may abound more and more in knowledge and depth of insight,

¹⁰ so that you may be <u>able to discern what is best and</u> may be pure and blameless for the day of Christ,

¹¹ filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ—to the glory and praise of God.

Philippians Ch 1:12 Paul's view from in chains

- The Philippians had expressed concern both about Paul's well being but also, they worried about his ability to fulfill his role as Apostle to the Gentiles.
- He had been under house arrest for 2 years

Paul tries to allay their fears

¹² Now I want you to know, brothers and sisters, that what has happened to me has <u>actually served</u> to advance the gospel.
