#### Philippians Ch 1:12

We begin where we ended:

12 Now I want you to know, brothers and sisters, that what has happened to me has actually served to advance the gospel.

## Philippians 1: 13-14

<sup>13</sup> As a result, it has become clear **throughout the whole palace guard** and to everyone else that *I am in chains for Christ*.

<sup>14</sup> And because of my chains, most of the brothers and sisters have become confident in the Lord and dare all the more to proclaim the gospel without fear.

## Philippians 1:15-18

- <sup>15</sup> It is true that some preach Christ out of envy and rivalry, but others out of goodwill.
- <sup>16</sup> The latter do so out of love, knowing that I am put here for the defense of the gospel.
- <sup>17</sup> The former preach Christ out of selfish ambition, not sincerely, supposing that they can stir up trouble for me while I am in chains.
- <sup>18</sup> But what does it matter? The important thing is that in every way, whether from false motives or true, Christ is preached. And because of this I rejoice.

Yes, and I will continue to rejoice,

## Philippians 1:19-21

<sup>19</sup> for I know that through your prayers and God's provision of the Spirit of Jesus Christ what has happened to me will turn out for my deliverance (or salvation)

<sup>20</sup> I eagerly expect and hope that I will in no way be ashamed but will have sufficient courage so that now as always Christ will be exalted in my body, whether by life or by death.

<sup>21</sup> For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain

## Philippians 1:22-26

- <sup>22</sup> If I am to go on living in the body, this will mean fruitful labor for me. Yet what shall I choose? I do not know!
- <sup>23</sup> I am torn between the two: I desire to depart and be with Christ, which is better by far;
- <sup>24</sup> but it is more necessary for you that I remain in the body.
- <sup>25</sup> Convinced of this, I know that I will remain, and I will continue with all of you for your progress and joy in the faith,
- <sup>26</sup> so that through my being with you again your boasting in Christ Jesus will abound on account of me.

#### Philippians 1:27 Living a Life worthy of the Gospel

<sup>27</sup> Whatever happens, conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the gospel of Christ.

Then, whether I come and see you, or only hear about you in my absence, I will know that you stand firm in the one Spirit, striving together as one for the faith of the gospel

#### John 16:33

<sup>33</sup> "I have told you these things, so that **in me** you may have peace.

In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world."

#### 3 Points for conducting ourselves to be worthy

- 2. Committed to resist any thoughts of dis-engaging from our trials
- 3. Committed to reject any dis-heartening perspectives
