GOD THE HOLY SPIRIT

Galatians 5:16

This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh.

Romans 7:15 For I do not understand what I am doing; for I am not practicing what I want to do, but I do the very thing I hate.

Romans 7:18 For I know that good does not dwell in me, that is, in my flesh; for the willing is present in me, but the doing of the good is not.

God has set a very high standard:

Matthew 5:48 Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect.

1 Peter 1:16 Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy.

1 John 2:6

The one who says he abides in Him, ought himself to walk in the same manner as He walked.

Romans 8:3-14:

- 3 For what the Law could not do, weak as it was through the flesh, God did: sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh and as an offering for sin, He condemned sin in the flesh, 4 so that the requirement of the Law might be fulfilled in us who do not walk according to the flesh but according to the Spirit. 5 For those who are in accord with the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but those who are in accord with the Spirit, the things of the Spirit.
- 6 For the mind set on the flesh is death, but the mind set on the Spirit is life and peace,
- 7 because the mind set on the flesh is hostile toward God; for it does not subject itself to the law of God, for it is not even able to do so,
- 8 and those who are in the flesh cannot please God.

- 9 However, you are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God dwells in you. But if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he does not belong to Him.
- 10 If Christ is in you, though the body is dead because of sin, yet the spirit is alive because of righteousness.
- 11 But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you.
- 12 So then, brothers and sisters, we are under obligation, not to the flesh, to live according to the flesh.
- 13 for if you are living in accord with the flesh, you are going to die; but if by the Spirit you are putting to death the deeds of the body, you will live.
- 14 For all who are being led by the Spirit of God, these are sons and daughters of God.

God sent his son:

Romans 8:4

so that the requirement of the Law might be fulfilled in us who do not walk according to the flesh but according to the Spirit.

Galatians 5:16

This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh.

John 16:7-8, 13-14

- 7 Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send him unto you.
- 8 And when he is come, he will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:
- 13 Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come.
- 14 He shall glorify me: for he shall receive of mine, and shall shew it unto you.

He was sent to comfort us:

John 16:7

Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send him unto you."

He was sent to teach us:

John 14:26

But the Comforter, which is the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall <u>teach</u> you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.

He was sent to glorify Jesus:

John 16:14

He shall glorify me: for he shall receive of mine, and shall shew it unto you.

<u>The Ministries of the Holy Spirit – From Ken Boa</u> Reflections Ministries

1. Convicting: He convicts us of sin:

John 16:8

8 And when he is come, he will reprove (convict) the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:

2. Regenerating: The Spirit imparts new life through the new birth, giving us the divine nature as a child of God.

Titus 3:5

Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost;

2 Peter 1:4

Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature,

3. Baptizing: By the Spirit, all believers in Christ have been baptized into one body.

1 Corinthians 12:13

For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body, whether we be Jews or Gentiles, whether we be bond or free; and have been all made to drink into one Spirit.

4. Sealing: The Holy Spirit seals us

Ephesians 1:13

In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were <u>sealed</u> with that Holy Spirit of promise,

Ephesians 1:14

Which is the earnest of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, unto the praise of his glory.

5. Indwelling: The Spirit of God indwells all believers in Christ so that our bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit who is in us.

Romans 8:9

But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his.

1 Corinthians 3:16

Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwelleth in you?

6. Filling: When we are filled by the Holy Spirit, we are under his control

Ephesians 5:18

And be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess; but be <u>filled</u> with the Spirit

The filling of the Spirit produces the fruit of Christian character and maturity

Acts 6:3

Wherefore, brethren, look ye out among you seven men of honest report, <u>full of the Holy Spirit</u> and wisdom, whom we may appoint over this business.

Acts 6:5

And the saying pleased the whole multitude: and they chose Stephen, a man <u>full</u> of faith and <u>of the Holy Spirit</u>,

7. Empowering: This is another aspect of the filling of the Spirit, and it relates to his sovereign power for ministry in word and deed.

Acts 4:8

Then Peter, <u>filled</u> with the Holy Ghost, said unto them, Ye rulers of the people, and elders of Israel, (this was after he preached and 5,000 men were saved)

Acts 4:31

And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all <u>filled</u> with the Holy Ghost, and they spake the word of God with boldness.

Acts 13:9-11

Then Saul, (who also is called Paul,) <u>filled</u> with the Holy Ghost, set his eyes on him, 10 And said, O full of all subtilty and all mischief, thou child of the devil, thou enemy of all righteousness, wilt thou not cease to pervert the right ways of the Lord? And now, behold, the hand of the Lord is upon thee, and thou shalt be blind, not seeing the sun for a season. And immediately there fell on him a mist and a darkness; and he went about seeking some to lead him by the hand.

8. Assuring: The Spirit testifies to the truth of our life in Christ and bears witness that we are children of God.

Romans 8:16

The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God:

1 John 3:24

And he that keepeth his commandments dwelleth in him, and he in him. And hereby we know that he abideth in us, by the Spirit which he hath given us.

1 John 5:7

For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Spirit: and these three are one.

9. <u>Illuminating</u>: The spirit of God who inspired the Scriptures also illuminates the Scriptures, "so that we may know the things freely given to us by God

1 Corinthians 2:10-16

- 10. But God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God.
- 11. For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? Even so the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God.
- 12. Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God.
- 13. Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual.
- 14. But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.
- 15. But he that is spiritual judgeth all things, yet he himself is judged of no man.
- 16. For who hath known the mind of the Lord, that he may instruct him? But we have the mind of Christ.

10. Teaching: Jesus promised His disciples that the Holy Spirit would teach and bring all things to your remembrance that he had told them.

John 14:26

But the Comforter, which is the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you. The Spirit glorifies the Son by making the words of Jesus known to us

John 16:14

He shall glorify me: for he shall receive of mine, and shall shew it unto you.

11. Praying: Because we do not know how to pray as we should, the Spirit intercedes for us:

Romans 8:26

Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.

When we pray in the Spirit:

Ephesians 6:18

Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;

We have access through Christ to the Father:

Ephesians 2:18

For through him we both have access by one Spirit unto the Father.

12. Gifting: The manifold gifts of the Holy Spirit are given to the faithful

1 Corinthians 12:4

Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit.

1 Corinthians 12:11

But one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing to each one individually just as he wills.

The Holy Spirit is at work in the lives of Christians:

The Holy Spirit will comfort us and teach us, but here is a quick review of the things that He will do in our lives as we yield ourselves to Him.

1. He'll control us, if we yield to Him:

Gal 5:16-18 This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh. For the flesh lusteth against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh: and these are contrary the one to the other: so that ye cannot do the things that ye would. But if ye be led of the Spirit, ye are not under the law.

2. He'll teach us, if we hear Him:

1 John 2:27 But the anointing which ye have received of him abideth in you, and ye need not that any man teach you: but as the same anointing teacheth you of all things, and is truth, and is no lie, and even as it hath taught you, ye shall abide in him."

3. He'll strengthen us, if we submit to Him:

Ephesians 3:16 "That he would grant you, according to the riches of his glory, to be strengthened with might by his Spirit in the inner man;

4. He'll lead us, if we will follow Him:

Romans 8:14 For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.

5. He'll empower us, if we ask Him:

Acts 1:8 But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Spirit is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

6. He'll love through us, if we allow Him:

Romans 5:5 And hope maketh not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Spirit which is given unto us.

- 7. He'll assure us, if we're sensitive to Him:
- 1 John 3:24 And he that keepeth his commandments dwelleth in him, and he in him. And hereby we know that he abideth in us, by the Spirit which he hath given us.
- **8. He'll fill us**, if we avail ourselves of Him: Ephesians 5:18 And be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess; but be filled with the Spirit;

- He can be reverenced (Ps 51:11) Cast me not away from thy presence; and take not thy holy spirit from me.
- He can be rebelled against (Isa 63:10) But they rebelled, and vexed his holy Spirit:
- He can be blasphemed (Mat 12:31-32) Wherefore I say unto you, All manner of sin and blasphemy shall be forgiven unto men: but the blasphemy against the Holy Spirit shall not be forgiven unto men. 32 And whosoever speaketh a word against the Son of man, it shall be forgiven him: but whosoever speaketh against the Holy Spirit, it shall not be forgiven him, neither in this world, neither in the world to come.
- •He can be lied to (Acts 5:3) But Peter said, Ananias, why hath Satan filled thine heart to lie to the Holy Spirit, and to keep back part of the price of the land?
- He can be resisted (Acts 7:51) Ye stiffnecked and uncircumcised in heart and ears, ye do always resist the Holy Spirit: as your fathers did, so do ye.
- He can be grieved (Eph 4:30) And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.
- •He can be spited (Heb 10:29) How much severer punishment do you think he will deserve who has trampled under foot the Son of God, and has regarded as unclean the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified, and has insulted the Spirit of grace?
